Tree Maintenance Intern

The Kansas Forest Service is placing an intern in the City of Greensburg to care for the trees that have been replanted after the devastating tornado in May of 2006. Applicants should possess a basic understanding of tree maintenance practices to insure a healthy and sustainable re-establishment of the tree planting projects. This individual will perform the following tree maintenance practices: planting, staking, mulching, irrigation, pruning, weed control and installation of drip irrigation. This person will be caring for all public trees planted in the parks, downtown and in the residential streetscape areas. Maintain Tree Walk/Arboretum at the Rodeo Grounds. They will also be the tree resource person for the City of Greensburg and its residents.
