Please list equipment requested and its' intended use (brush engine, water tender, etc.).

Requirements for Equipment Acquisition

1. Vehicles:
 - ◆ 1 Ton 4x4 for use as a brush engine, single wheel, restricted to 250 gallons max.
 - ◆ 1 Ton 4x4 for use as a brush engine, dual wheel, restricted to 300 gallons max.
 - ◆ 2 ½ Ton 6x6 for use as a brush engine, restricted to 500 gallons max.
 - ◆ 2 ½ Ton 6x6 for use as a water tender, restricted to 1000 gallons max.
 - ◆ 5 Ton 6x6 for use as a brush engine, restricted to 1000 gallons max.
 - ◆ 5 Ton 6x6 for use as a water tender, restricted to 2000 gallons max.

* Note: Vehicles can not exceed gross vehicle weight rating.
2. The department/district shall assume responsibility for all loaned FEPP including insurance required by state law.
3. Equipment will be used only for fire protection purposes or during natural disasters.
4. Vehicles will be converted for fire control and painted within 180 days.

5. Equipment will be provided adequate security and housing facilities.
6. Equipment will not be sold, cannibalized, traded, transferred, exchanged, donated or otherwise disposed of, in whole or in part, without written approval of the Kansas Forest Service and the USDA Forest Service.
7. All excess property will be made available for periodic inventory and inspection by the Kansas Forest Service. Title remains with the USDA Forest Service.
